1420. Erosion of The Green

Large lorries delivering to Maces Farm have been driving onto the Green when turning into the farm and causing extensive erosion of the grass. Repairs are currently in operation.

SJ is obtaining quotes for replacing old posts and installing new posts in the area of the Green from the school to just before the pavilion. The posts will be cemented in to prevent removal. The owner of the Green has not previously wanted posts all the way round.

TD has suggested writing to Maces Farm pointing out the damage which is being caused. CM will draft a suitable letter, to be sent by the clerk.

1421. Upcoming Pegasi consultation exhibition

Pegasi are progressing with an amended planning proposal of 110 houses on the football pitch area. They will offer an alternative site for an all-weather pitch with changing rooms. The proposal is still for rental properties only.

1422. Events

1423. Councillor training

1424. Defibrillator responsibility

Ljiljana would like to step down as co-ordinator. A search is therefore on for a replacement. SJ would like to know what would be involved in the position.

1425. Recruitment of new councillors

The council should be looking to find applicants for the two existing vacancies. CM suggested giving a presentation at village events to explain what is involved with being a parish councillor.

1426. Footpaths update

There is no further update. The council needs to ensure that Maces Farm cut their footpaths to the correct width.

1427. B1383 update

Some of the overgrowth has now been cut. There is now space to walk along the footway without stepping onto the road, but the footway itself still needs work by Highways to clear it properly.

1428. Capital Projects for the Village

This is still being collated with suggestions invited.

1429. Neighbourhood Plan

Brendan Chapman (BC) was unable to attend the most recent meeting. Most activity for the Plan relates to Newport. There will be a consultation with the village. BC will speak to the organisers regarding the format.

1430. Pond maintenance

Ecologists turned up in the pouring rain and looked at both ponds. They will return soon to do a proper search for evidence of Greater Crested Newts (GCN). They will contact the contractors to agree what is to be done and how to proceed, but would hope to be able to get the paperwork done before the end of the month – once into March the pond comes alive again and they would be unwilling to authorize works once spring is sprung.

Their first impressions – good newt habitat at Brick Kiln pond, not so good at Dell pond. It would appear that there has been some hydrocarbon leak into Dell pond as the water is murky grey/black. This could just be run-off from the road or possibly from Maces Farm vehicle maintenance. Time has run out this year to apply for a GCN licence.
